PITTSBURG — Theresa D. Noyes, 88, of Pittsburg, passed away on Thursday, Sept. 19, 2019, in the same home in which she was born after a long period of declining health and surrounded by her family.

She was born in Pittsburg on July 8, 1931, a daughter to the late Joseph and Celanire (Benoit) Chaloux. She attended St. Albert's School and married Lawrence Noyes in 1950.

Theresa worked for the Beecher Falls Division of Ethan Allen for 23 years, and later worked in the housekeeping department at the Coös County Nursing Home for 6 years. After retiring, she enjoyed traveling and spending her winters in Stuart, Fla. She enjoyed walking and hand-feeding the deer in her back yard, doing puzzles, reading, and loved being with and in contact with her family. She loved classic country & western music, and was probably Elvis Presley's biggest fan.
