



Timothy E. Parker

February 6, 1957 - April 8, 2014

COLEBROOK, NH -- Timothy Earl Parker, 57, of Colebrook, passed away at the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center in Lebanon, NH, on Tuesday evening, April 8, 2014, after a months-long battle with cancer.

He was born on Feb. 6, 1957, in West Stewartstown, the eldest son of Lyford and Eileen (Purrington) Parker, Sr. He was raised in East Colebrook and on Titus Hill in Columbia and attended the Colebrook schools.

Tim began working at a young age, sweeping streets for the Town of Colebrook when he was 13, and he also worked at Lambert's grocery store. Later, Tim worked as a security guard at The Balsams Grand Resort Hotel in Dixville, while also working as a private investigator in his spare time. He did other security work over the years, as well, for Eddie Nash & Sons and later Nash Equipment. He was a music lover and loved to play drums and guitar. He was well known as the leader of the local band "Thunder Valley Express" for many years. For most of his years, Tim lived at the family home on Titus Hill Road, Parker Manor, and he enjoyed taking care of the property with his mother. For the past couple of years, he had resided at Colby Commons, where he was well liked and he enjoyed helping other residents by moving cars in the winter, adjusting television sets for others, and just being a good neighbor. His other favorite pastimes were watching WWE wrestling and martial arts.

Tim is survived by his mother, Eileen Parker of Colebrook; his father, Lyford Parker, Sr. and Reona Hartlen of Colebrook; two sisters, Tamie Parker Marsh and Tina Marie Parker of Colebrook; a brother, Lyford Parker, Jr.; a half-sister, Amanda Parker of Colebrook and her son, Dagan; two nieces, Collette Marsh and her fiancé Todd Martel and Rhiannon Scott Wilkie and her husband Jared and their children, Dawson Scott-Marsh, Deniyah Wilkie and Collin Wilkie.

He is preceded in death by a brother-in-law, Dennis Marsh.

There are no public calling hours. A celebration of Tim's life will be held later in the summer at the Parker Manor, of which notice will be given.
