



## Vincent M. Jeffers

January 18, 1966 - May 20, 2026

COLUMBIA – Vincent Miles Jeffers, 60, of Columbia, passed away unexpectedly at his home early on Wednesday, May 20, 2026.

He was born on Jan. 18, 1966, in West Stewartstown, a son to Roland and Louisette (Robidas) Jeffers. Vince attended St. Albert's School in Stewartstown and four years at Colebrook Academy, graduating in 1985.

Vince worked as a truck driver for several years before being employed at Ethan Allen in Beecher Falls, Vt. After the factory closed, he found his true calling as a LNA at the Coos County Nursing Hospital where he worked for the past 14 years. His compassion and kindness shined through in his work. He was loved by both the residents and his co-workers.

Vince was a devoted member of the River of Life Church and loved God deeply. He especially loved playing his bass guitar on the church worship team. He was a big Elvis fan and enjoyed doing tribute shows at local events. He also enjoyed NASCAR racing, fishing, and spending time with his family.

He will be remembered for his strong faith, caring heart, and a willingness to always lend a hand.

He is survived by his wife of 24 years, Lisa (Lafond) Jeffers of Columbia; his

daughter, Khristina Wentworth of Colebrook; his mother, Louissette Jeffers of Colebrook; a sister, Lisa Boudle and husband Steve of Groveton; three step-children, Johnny Riendeau of Farmington, N.H., Jamie Riendeau of Naples, Fla., and Jenny (Louis) Thomas of Laconia, N.H.; 3 grandchildren: Conner, Emmett, and Silas Wentworth; and a niece, Claudia Snowman.

He was predeceased by his father, Roland M. Jeffers, in 2013.

There are no public calling hours. A graveside memorial service and celebration of his life will be held on Sunday, June 28, 2026, at 1 p.m. in the Colebrook Village Cemetery.
