



## Warren "Red" E. Rodimon

July 11, 1928 - December 9, 2007

COLUMBIA, NEW HAMPSHIRE -- Mr. Warren "Red" E. Rodimon, 79, of Turner Road in Columbia, New Hampshire, passed away early on Sunday, December 9, 2007, at Weeks Medical Center in Lancaster, NH.

Mr. Rodimon was born July 11, 1928, in Springfield, Mass., a son of the late Vernon W. Rodimon, Sr. and Olga (Lunden) Rodimon.

Red spent his early years in the Hampden, Mass. area, before moving to Florida and subsequently to New Hampshire. He attended schools in Hampden and Springfield, Mass., and served with honor in the U.S. Navy just after World War II. He ran an active trucking and stone-crushing business in Monson, Mass. for many years and then retired to Florida. Red's most recent years were spent in his beloved New Hampshire on Turner Road and Marshall Hill in Columbia.

Mr. Rodimon leaves behind his sister, Beverly Bowman and husband, G. Grant Bowman, of Worthington, Mass.; a sister-in-law, Merle W. Rodimon of Stafford, Ct.; and several nieces and nephews.

Mr. Rodimon is preceded in death by his wife, Margaret V. Rodimon; a sister, Pearl G. Stone; a brother, Vernon W. Rodimon, Jr.; and a beloved nephew, Kevin J. Stone.

The Rodimon family will receive relatives and friends on Sunday, December 16, 2007, from 1 – 3 p.m. at the Jenkins & Newman Funeral Home, 103 Main Street, in Colebrook, NH. Burial will take place in the spring in Hampden, Mass.
