



Wilfred I. Noyes

July 7, 1930 - December 4, 2020

COLEBROOK— Wilfred I. Noyes, 90, of Colebrook, died on Friday, Dec. 4, 2020 at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown with his wife by his side.

Wilfred was the son of the late Ira and Bessie (Gould) Noyes, and he was born in Colebrook on July 7, 1930. He was raised on the family farm in East Colebrook. Fred was a 1948 graduate of Colebrook Academy and later served with honor in the U.S. Navy from 1949-53.

After his military service, Fred worked for a time at Ethan Allen and then for a time at the Tillotson Rubber Co. in Dixville, and later as the sawmill operator and supervisor again at Ethan Allen. He was a talented renovator and a skilled craftsman.

Fred was an excellent and devoted father, and he was proud to be from the north country. He loved the area around Pittsburg and enjoyed time at his camp in Indian Stream, hunting and snowmobiling. He also loved to be out fishing on the local lakes and streams. He was very generous of spirit and loved to help other people.

Fred leaves behind his beloved wife of 63 years, Elsie (Stevens) Noyes, of West Stewartstown, and their six children, Thomas Lewis of Nebraska, Debra

Lewis of Florida, Ramona Cameron of Colebrook, David Noyes of Laconia, NH, Alan Noyes of Claremont, and Bradley Noyes of Florida; his sister, Betty Frizzell, of Lemington, Vt.; as well as 16 grandchildren, numerous great-grandchildren and 2 great-great-grandchildren.

He is preceded in death by four brothers and six sisters.

A graveside service with military honors will be at a future date in the Colebrook Village Cemetery, of which notice will be given.
