



Wilfred "Tink" C. Washburn, Jr.

September 12, 1938 - May 7, 2005

Mr. Wilfred "Tink" C. Washburn, Jr., of Columbia, NH, passed away Saturday evening, May 7, 2005, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital following a courageous battle with cancer and leukemia. Tink was born September 12, 1938, in Kittery, NH, son of the late Wilfred C. Washburn, Sr. and Ruth (Clark) Washburn. Tink graduated from Colebrook Academy in 1956 and served honorably in the United States Navy from 1956-1960. Throughout his life he held a variety of jobs. He worked at the Wilderness Ski Area and for Carl Edwards and Daniel Hebert. He worked also as an investigator for Ivory Cobb, for the Stratford Plywood Company, the Canadian National Railroad, the John Hancock Insurance Company becoming the top salesman that year, and the Groveton Paper Company.
