NORTH STRATFORD – William A. Hurley, 81, of North Stratford died at the Country Village Healthcare Center in Lancaster, N.H., on Saturday, Aug. 12, 2023, after a period of failing health.

He was born in Island Pond, Vt., on Dec. 21, 1941, a eldest son to the late Alton and Grace (Weatherstone) Hurley.

William was affectionately known by all as “Snookie,” and was considered the unofficial “Mayor of North Stratford.” He worked for many companies over the years, but was a long-time flagman for Winterset construction company.
