January 21, 1925 - May 6, 2018

STEWARTSTOWN – Winona E. Lynch, 93, of Stewartstown passed away on Sunday evening, May 6, 2018, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital with her family by her side, and after a brief period of declining health.

She was born at home in Stewartstown on Jan. 21, 1925, a daughter of the late Ellis and Carrie (Gardner) Hibbard. She attended schools in Stewartstown and Colebrook. She later married F. Robert Lynch and worked the farm with him for many years while raising their family together.

Winona also drove her own school bus for the local children for 42 years. She also did housekeeping for Rippling Brook Cabins in Columbia and Rudy's Cabins in Clarksville for many years. Her greatest joy was time spent with her family who will all remember her as a loving mother and grandmother, a wonderful cook, and for always helping others, especially local senior citizens.
