



Winston G. Parkhurst

COLUMBIA, NH — Mr. Winston G. Parkhurst, 72, of Columbia, passed away at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook on Sunday morning, July 21, 2013.

He was born on April 22, 1941, in West Stewartstown, a son of the late Lynn and Madeline (Gadwah) Parkhurst. Winston was a graduate of Colebrook Academy in the Class of 1959.

For many years, he was a co-owner and operator of L. Parkhurst & Sons hardware store in Columbia along with his family until the sale of the business. He was a very private man, who enjoyed fishing and tying flies. He also used to hunt a bit in his younger days.

Winston is survived by his brother Kenneth Parkhurst and wife Isabelle of Columbia; another brother, Robert Parkhurst of Florida; as well as a nephew, Garry Parkhurst; and three nieces, Sheila Parkhurst, Lori MacDonald and Norine Sabine. Winston is preceded in death by a brother, Erwin Parkhurst.
