PITTSBURG, NEW HAMPSHIRE – Mrs. Yvette (Cotnoir) Boutin, 94, of Pittsburg, New Hampshire, passed away Sunday morning, May 17, 2009, at the St. Francis Rehabilitation and Nursing Center in Laconia, New Hampshire.
