



## Yvon D. Dagesse

February 28, 1936 - October 24, 2012

WEST STEWARTSTOWN, NH—Mr. Yvon D. Dagesse, of West Stewartstown, passed away peacefully at the Fletcher Allen Health Care Center in Burlington, Vt., early Wednesday morning, Oct. 24, 2012.

He was born on Feb. 28, 1936, in Courcelles, Québec, son of the late Levis and Eva (Lessard) Dagesse.

Yvon worked for the Brown Company from 1952-55 as an assistant cook. After that, he worked as a woodsman in Ontario for a time before returning to the U.S. in 1958. He then began a long career at the Beecher Falls Division of Ethan Allen for the next 41 years.

Yvon enjoyed working outside on his lawn and landscaping his home, but his greatest joy was spending time with his family. He was also a great card player, and had a sharp, sarcastic sense of humor.

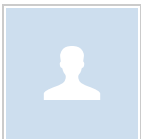

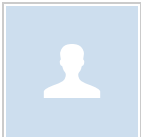

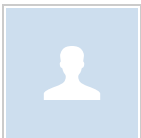
