



Zelma "Dot" Uran

February 22, 1918 - July 9, 2009

LEMINGTON, VERMONT – Mrs. Zelma “Dot” (Foster) Uran, 91, of Lemington, Vermont, passed away unexpectedly at her home Thursday afternoon, July 9, 2009.

Dot was born on February 22, 1918, on Canaan Hill in Canaan, VT, a daughter of the late Charles and Elsie (Haynes) Foster.

Dot was a homemaker who enjoyed caring for her home and her family, raising ten children.
